- Assist in budget preparation and monitor expenditures to stay within allotted amounts
- Assist project leads to manage, monitor, and report on project milestones through detailed plans and schedules, ensuring projects are on budget, on schedule, and within scope
- Conduct and participate in meetings with internal teams and external collaborators (e.g., consultants, contractors, community groups)
- Provide professional landscape architectural input and review for the development of strategic policy related to parks and open space service delivery
- Support City-wide initiatives and other City Planning Branch Priorities that relate to parks and open space
- Continually work to improve processes and develop best practices within the Open Space Planning & Design section
- Perform other related duties as assigned
